In the opening match, Lanarkshire won 8-3 against ROI Leinster with Toni Woods winning all three of her rubbers, including two 3 set matches in the Women's Singles 2 and Women's Doubles 1 with Team Manager Kirsten Berry. In the afternoon, Lanarkshire faced Yorkshire 1. It was a strong start with Lanarkshire leading 4-0 taking all four of the singles rubbers. However Yorkshire produced a strong set of performances in the doubles taking the match 7-4.
